WE WELCOME TO OUR PULPIT TODAY...

The Rev. Dr. Donn D. Moomaw.

Rev. Moomaw was raised in Santa Ana, CA. He received a B.S. from UCLA, a Master of Divinity from Princeton Theological Seminary and a Doctor of Divinity from Sterling College. An All-American linebacker for UCLA in the early fifties, Rev. Moomaw was the first round draft choice for the Rams in 1953, but turned down the offer because, as a new Christian, he didn’t want to play games on Sundays. He instead chose to accept an offer to play for the Canadian Pro Football League. He went on to help launch the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA). Rev. Moomaw was ordained a Presbyterian (USA) pastor in 1957, served as Assistant Pastor for First Pres. Church, Berkeley, CA from 1957-1964, and then served 28 years as senior pastor for Bel Air Presbyterian Church, following Rev. Louis Evans. As President Reagan’s pastor, Rev. Moomaw prayed at both of his inaugurations in 1981 and 1985. After serving two interim pastorates, Rev. Moomaw is presently writing, guest teaching and preaching, and enjoying traveling with his wife of 48 years, Carol. They have five children and 9 grandchildren.
