Children’s Ministry Volunteer Opportunities 2010 Year

Below is a short synopsis of many of the CM positions we are seeking to fill. Please contact Charles for more information about any of the positions.

- B-2’s teacher** – (10 teachers needed)
2 services a month you’ll hold babies and play with 2 year olds, creating a safe, secure environment so that children’s first experience with church are joy filled ones.

- 3-5 Teachers** – (10 teachers needed)
2 services a month you’ll play with pre-k kids, teaching them simple and fun lessons that will open their minds and hearts to the wonder, love, and joy of knowing Jesus (lessons and supplies are completely prepared and provided for you)

- Kdg./1st Grade Teacher** – (4 teachers needed)
Up to three services a month you’ll leave worship just before the sermon and help Kdg./1st graders develop relationships with each other, while learning about God’s love for them and how the Big God Story is something we’re invited to participate in too.

- 2nd-4th Grade Teacher** – (4 teachers needed)
Two to four services a month you’ll leave worship just before the sermon and help kids: develop relationships with each other, know foundational truths of our faith, know God’s love for them, and how they can play a role in God’s Big Story.

- 5th-6th Grade Teacher** – (4 teachers needed)
Two to four services a month you’ll leave worship just before the sermon and help pre-teens: develop relationships with each other, learn the facts of faith, personalize God’s love for them, and know how they can play a role in God’s Big Story.

- Substitute teachers** – (12 Substitutes needed)
Substitute teachers will serve one to two services every month whichever services there are holes in the teaching rotations or when teachers are unavailable.

- SiFi Small group leaders** – (2 are needed)

SiFi is a Wednesday night program for 6th/5th graders equipping them to know their identity in Christ Jesus. Small group leaders would attend SiFi on Wednesday nights (7-8:30) and SiFi events, building relationships with the preteens and walking alongside them at a joyous and fun filled time.

Children's Ministry Greeters – (4 are Needed)

Greeters serve every Sunday for 25 minutes (10 minutes into the service) greeting kids and families, helping them check in, and assisting new families with information, directions, and most importantly-a warm welcome!

Kids Musical/Choir Leadership Team (4-6 are Needed)

The leadership team would work under the direction of Dan and Charles to develop and run a Christmas Kids play/musical and/or possible kids choir.

Children's Ministry Band/Worship Leaders – (2 are wanted)

Band leaders would put together and lead bands that would lead worship for Pre-K and elementary aged kids starting at 6 times a year. Would work with Charles to develop song selections/worship experience.

Children's Ministry Band – (3-10 are hoped for)

Band members would participate in band(s), leading worship for Pre-K and elementary aged kids about 6 times a year.

Mural/Décor painters and designers (as many as we can get)

We are currently developing themes for the rooms we use on Sunday's morning. We need one mural painted ASAP and will have numerous other ideas/hopes that we'll need artist and painters to help bring to life. These will help create an environment where kids feel safe and comfortable which will remove distractions and increase their learning.

Pre-K Worship Leader – (2-4 are needed)

This position will lead worship regularly for the Birth through 5 year old classes using great Preschool worship CD's we have all ready. We just need fun, energetic people willing to be a little silly. While this position will need to serve most Sunday's, they'll only miss a few minutes of the worship service each week as they won't stay in the classrooms.

Specific Skill/Arts Teachers - (As many as have a passion to teach anything)

We'd love to offer classes in art, music, dance, worship leading, or any other special/unique skill you have a passion to teach and which we can use to help kids understand God, His creation, and how that activity can be used to glorify Him. While we can't promise we can do them all, we'd like to know what options are in our congregation so make sure to pass on the Charles what you might want to teach.

Special Needs Buddies – (2-8)

Special Needs Buddies would come along side several special needs children who attend on Sunday mornings, helping them experience the love of Jesus and ensuring a great experience for them.
